

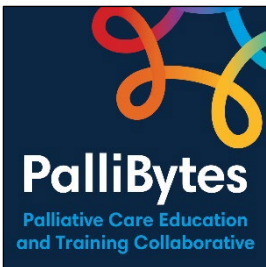
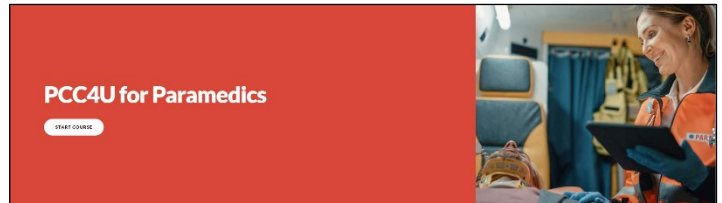
PCC4U Implementation Guide for Paramedic Educators
